

Countryside Twist Card

1. The card base is 4 1/4 X 11. Score at 5 1/2, and place a tic mark at 4 1/4.
2. Score from the tic mark to the opposite corner. Now flip the card over so the angled score is on the left.
3. Fold the card on the 5 1/2 score line and it will look like the top left photo.
4. The angled score line should run from the bottom to the top right, looking at the phot from the left picture stand leg to top right.
5. Fold that angle back so that the edge is flush at the top.
6. cut a piece of corresponding card stock to 4 X 4. Adhere it to only the folded back flap. That is what allows the card to "twist" when opened.
